One Day Lone Star Quilt

Honest! You can piece this beautiful 35" block in one day! Choose a color palette, pre-cut your strips and come ready to sew for a quick and not too challenging design. This is not for beginners.

Advanced Beginners who know how to rotary cut and sew an accurate 1/4" seam will be fine, but if you are unsure about your seam allowance, PRACTICE at home so you can sew with confidence. All patterns and illustrations are provided as part of the class fee.



Materials you will need (choose your favorite color palette):

- 1 yard fabric for background; you can choose a solid, a texture, or other fabric that works well with the 5 fabrics you choose for the star points.
- 1/4 yard inner border
- 1 yard outer border fabric
- 1/3 yard binding

For star points, refer to the 2 quilts and the line drawing at the left in order to determine your fabric placement.

- Colors #1 and #5 (the two reds in the top photo) - 1/4 yd EACH
- Colors #2 and #4 (the light gold and the brown/gold) - 1/3 yd EACH
- Color #3 (the green) - 3/8 yd

50" square backing and batting (for finishing; can be purchased at a later date)

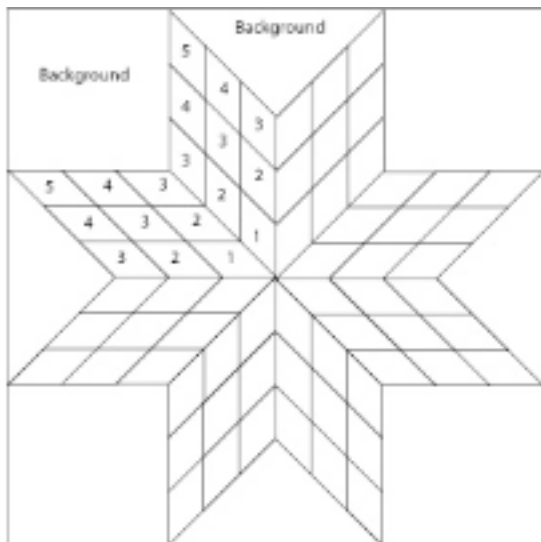
****Please bring all rotary cutting tools, especially a ruler with the 45 degree line marked and a 12-1/2" square.

Please pre-cut your strips as follows (DO NOT REMOVE SELVEDGES):

- One 3" strip of BOTH Colors #1 and #5
- Two 3" strips of BOTH Colors #2 and #4 Three (3) 3" strips of Color #3

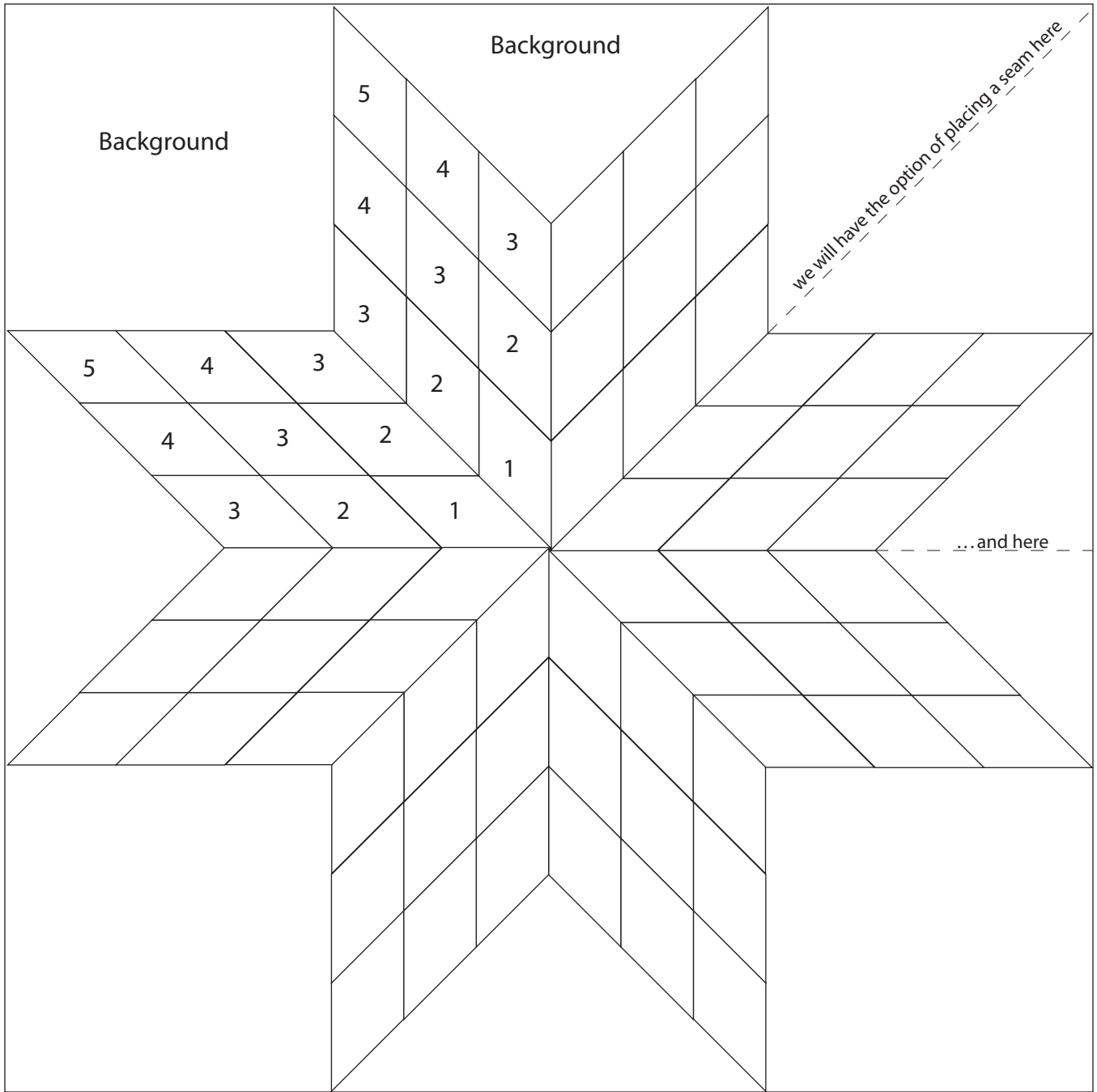
Bring remainders of these fabrics to class

***Since we will be working with bias edges, it is advisable to lightly starch your strips beforehand or at least bring some spray sizing or starch to class.



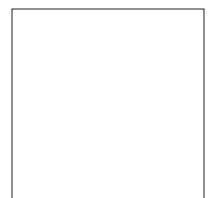
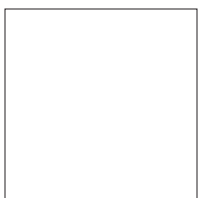
It is helpful to make a fabric mockup with tiny swatches. Note that there are 8 identical star points. ****The option of "splitting" the background squares and triangles for ease of construction will be offered (for those who do not wish to use set-in or y-seams).
