

Circles of Geese© - All day workshop with Debby Kratovil



Geese at the Zoo block
Block split into 4 smaller units
Unit size: 12"; with sashes 26" x 26"



My Geese Have the Blues - 38" x 38"
Unit size: 12"; with sashes 30" x 30"

Wow!! Such a big block and so easy to piece. The circle of geese is foundation pieced. One full circle (as seen in the quilts below) comprises of 8 separate units of 3 geese each. The quilts at the top split the circle for more manageable sections. The quarter circles and the outer background pieces are sewn with the geese rings - gentle and easy curves (because they are so big.)

The two quilts below utilize a single piece of focus fabric which is faced and then appliquéd to the center. Packs a lot of punch when you can see a fabulous piece of fabric showcased like this. Students will learn both techniques and choose their own finish.

Supply list will also include pre-cutting of strips. A pattern fee of \$4 will cover the cost of all necessary foundations. A multi-page handout with clear illustrations for all 4 versions is included. I will include my Magical Mitring lesson, also.
