## Batik Fans Paper-Pieced on Coffee Filters© Debby Kratovil - kratovil@his.com <br> 3 Hour Class All Skill Levels Machine Class



Yes, you read that right! We will use large size, round coffee filters as our foundation paper to piece these eyepopping fans. No need for a compass, pre-printed patterns, or special computer software programs. Just a pencil, ruler and coffee filter and you're on your way to a show-stopping quilt. Bring all those leftover 2-1/2" strips of batiks you've been saving! I supply the coffee filters and basic instructions.

Pattern pack is available for $\$ 5$ (includes quilt layout diagram, pre-printed templates and color photo).

## Fabric Supplies for a 12 Block Quilt:

- $1 / 2$ yard black multi-print or other color of your choice for background
- $1 / 4$ yard print for inner border
- Two LONG quarters ( $9^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ ) of contrasting fabric for border and binding
- Several fat eighths/quarters and/or 2-1/2" leftover strips variety of prints for fans
- Machine embroidery or nylon thread for top stitching fans (Variegated threads work well)
- Four $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ sheets of freezer paper

This is a sewing machine class which assumes student is familiar with the sewing machine she brings to class. If in doubt, practice sewing $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seams and zigzag stitches on scraps at home. Bring all cutting supplies, scissors, thread, etc. NOT FOR BRAND NEW SEWERS OR QUILTERS, though this is a very easy class.
