3 Hour Class All Skill Levels Machine Class



Block Size: 6"

Quilt Size: 24" x 30"

Yes, you read that right! We will use large size, round coffee filters as our foundation paper to piece these eyepopping fans. No need for a compass, pre-printed patterns, or special computer software programs. Just a pencil, ruler and coffee filter and you're on your way to a show-stopping quilt. Bring all those leftover 2-1/2" strips of batiks you've been saving! **I supply the coffee filters and basic instructions**.

Pattern pack is available for \$5 (includes quilt layout diagram, pre-printed templates and color photo).

Fabric Supplies for a 12 Block Quilt:

- 1/2 yard black multi-print or other color of your choice for background
- 1/4 yard print for inner border
- Two LONG quarters (9" x 42") of contrasting fabric for border and binding
- Several fat eighths/quarters and/or 2-1/2" leftover strips variety of prints for fans
- Machine embroidery or nylon thread for top stitching fans (Variegated threads work well)
- Four 8-1/2" x 11" sheets of freezer paper

This is a sewing machine class which assumes student is familiar with the sewing machine she brings to class. If in doubt, practice sewing 1/4" seams and zigzag stitches on scraps at home. Bring all cutting supplies, scissors, thread, etc. NOT FOR BRAND NEW SEWERS OR QUILTERS, though this is a very easy class.
