

DOGWOOD BLOSSOM QUILT

Block Size: 7"

Quilt Size: 31" x 38"

Supply list for a **12 block quilt** with borders:

- Six colors for "points" - either a fat 8th yd EACH or one 2-1/2" strip of EACH
- 1/2 yard for background of points
- 1/2 yard for block backgrounds
- 12 squares 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" for the curved base of blocks (can be cut from Fat 8ths from above)
- 1/4 yard for inner border
- 1/2 yard for outer border
- 1/3 yard for binding
- Tablet of newsprint for making our foundation patterns (I supply master pattern)
- Batting and backing can be purchased at a later time



Block Size: 7"

Quilt Size: 40" x 40"

Supply list for a **16 block quilt** with borders:

- Scraps for Points (variety of 2-1/2" strips) or 6-8 fat eighths of a variety of colors
- 5/8 yard for background of points (light)
- For rainbow effect, 16 squares 7-1/2" x 7-1/2" for the block backgrounds, otherwise 1 yard of a single color
- 16 squares 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" for the curved base of the blocks (1/3 yd of one color will work)
- 3/4 yard for border
- 1/3 yard for binding
- Tablet of newsprint (see above)

EXTRA NOTES

We will be paper piecing the arcs and points (easy, trust me). And yes, there are two curved pieces to each block. These are gentle curves and if you have an accurate 1/4" skill and know how to use your sewing machine, you will succeed.

Extra supplies for EACH of the two quilts featured:

- 1/2 yard of lightweight interfacing (NOT FUSIBLE)
- small spool of nylon or polyester invisible thread (for our machine applique of the small 1/4 circle)

PRE-CUTTING the strips for paper piecing the points:

For **each block** you plan to make:

- Six 2-1/2" x 4" rectangles of your background fabric with the points
- Five 2" x 4" rectangles of colors **for** the points

I will supply 1 master pattern and 2-3 printed paper foundations for working in class. The newsprint is so that you can make multiple copies using needle-punch techniques to transfer the markings. A set of 16 extra printed patterns for paper piecing can be purchased from me the day of workshop for \$3.00.

Please bring

- a sewing machine you are FAMILIAR with and can get an accurate 1/4" seam allowance.
- all purpose foot (for the zig zag applique using the nylon, invisible thread)
- **Add-a-Quarter** ruler is STRONGLY recommended
- a 9-1/2" or 12-1/2" square ruler
- thread, basic rotary cutting supplies, etc
