Block Size: 18"
Runner Size: 32" x 52"

One BIG block made of 3 easy units (one is paper pieced). Learn new triangle techniques, master others and let your fabric do the rest of the work!

Use Fabrics A - E in Color Chart on next page to help plan your blocks.
 FABRIC A: 1-1/3 yard multi-print for blocks and sashing strips
 FABRIC B: 5/8 yard light background fabric for blocks and sashing squares
 FABRIC C: 1-1/2 yard multi-print fabric (border and binding)
 FABRIC D: 1/4 yard fabric to contrast with Fabrics 1 and 2 (in my sample above, the dark orange)
 FABRIC E: Fat eighth of print for centers of square-in-square unit
 1-5/8 yard backing (can be purchased at a later date)
 Craft sized batting
 Add-a-Quarter ruler; neutral thread, rotary cutting tools. Pre-cutting information on next pages.



Facets of Color Lap Quilt

Block Size: 18" Quilt Size: 64" x 64"

Four BIG blocks make for a quick and super sized quilt making good use of large scale print fabrics.

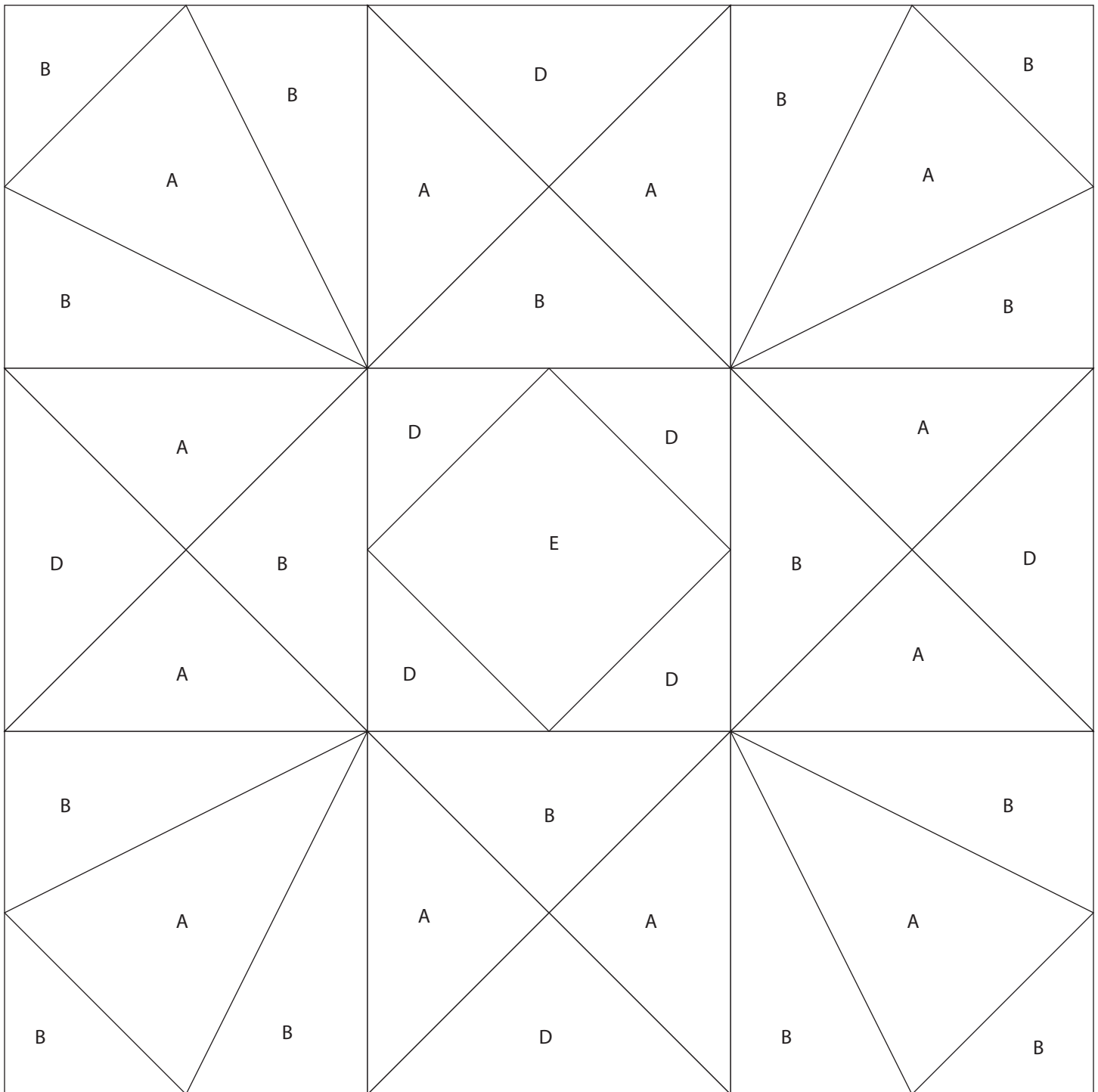
Note: select colors you enjoy working with; I identify the colors I used just to simplify which patches use which yardage amounts

FABRIC 1: 1 yd for blocks & sashings
 FABRIC 2: 3/4 yd for background (green)
 FABRIC 3: 2-1/2 yds for border & binding
 FABRIC 4: 1/4 yd for blocks (hot pink)
 FABRIC 5: 1-1/4 yd for blocks (center of square in square and block corner units - blue)
 FABRIC 6: 3/4 yd for blocks (Lavender)
 FABRIC 7: 1/2 yd for inner border
 4 yards backing; Twin sized batting
 All rotary cutting tools, mat; neutral piecing thread.
 Add-a-quarter ruler is a MUST.

Select your own colors - let the fabric do all the work!

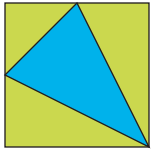
Facets of Color Block Coloring Chart

Pre-cutting for Units

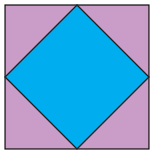


Corner Unit
This will be paper pieced

For EACH block, cut:
8 rectangles 5" x 7-1/2"
2 squares 4-1/2"



4 squares 7" x 7"

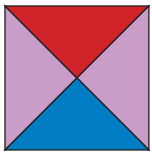


Center Unit

For EACH block, cut:
1 square 6-1/2"



4 squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"



Outside Center

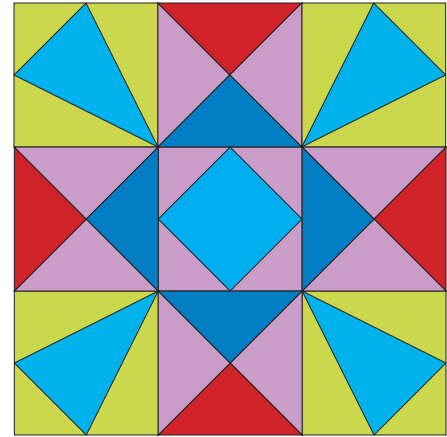
For EACH block, cut:
1 square 7-1/4"



2 squares 7-1/4"



1 square 7-1/4"
