Class with Debby Kratovil
All Day Workshop (6 hours)



Block Size: 21"
Number of Blocks in Quilt: 4
Quilt Size: 69" x 69"

REALLY big, oversized blocks are the perfect place to capture large scale floral prints. The sharp points are a breeze with paper piecing techniques. Debby will turn even the novice quilter into a skilled paper piecer with her patterns and easy, step by step lessons that takes the fear out of foundation piecing.

Supplies

1/4 yard EACH of 4 fabrics for star points (orange, brown, purple, green)
1/4 yard yellow for inner border (or color of choice)
1 yard light orange dot fabric for block backgrounds (or color of choice)
1 yard large scale floral for blocks
2-1/2 yards stripe for outer border (to miter); 2 yards for NON-miter
Add-a-Quarter ruler (12" preferred)
Tablet of newsprint (for needlepunching our duplicate patterns)
Twin sized batting (can be purchased at a later date)
4 yards backing (can be purchased at a later date)

Please do NOT bring a sewing machine you are unfamiliar with.

If you would like to precut your strips and squares for your blocks

- Five 7-1/2" squares floral print for EACH block (20 squares total)
- Eight 2-1/2" x 8" strips for EACH colored star (8 green, 8 purple, etc for points)
- Eight 2-1/2" x 4-3/4" strips for EACH colored star (8 green, 8 purple, etc for points)
- Thirty-two 2-1/2" x 8" strips light background print for star points units
- Sixteen 4-1/4" x 8" strips light background print for star points units

We will discuss sashings and borders in class.

Students will receive basic patterns for copying (needlepunch) and all instructions to complete the quilt as pictured above. Option: \$4 pattern fee for all foundations.
