Quilt Size: 56" x 56"

This is a sewing machine class. Hand appliqué are welcome but I WILL NOT BE teaching hand appliqué. Do not come to learn hand appliqué. I use a zigzag sewing machine stitch - simple for anyone!

PATTERN IS PROVIDED!

In this 6 hour class we will learn:

- transfer of template markings to freezer paper
- use of fusible webs. I prefer TransWeb®
- folding center square for accurate placement of the appliqué patches
- use of stabilizers, threads, and quick machine stitch options

Students should expect to get their center arranged and "basted" in the first 2-4 hours. For those using their sewing machines, you should be able to begin the appliqué by machine. This pattern is also excellent for hand appliqué.

Fabric Requirements - PLEASE SELECT YOUR OWN COLOR COMBINATIONS AS YOU DESIRE

1 yard muslin or other fabric for background center square - Please precut to 32" x 32"

Fat eighths (9" x 22") of the following fabrics

25119 (medium purple, dark purple, blue, green); 25126 (yellow, pink)

25120 (red, orange, black, purple); 25123 (yellow, purple, pink)

25121 (light blue); 25122 (light yellow, hot pink)

25124 (green, red - center); 25125 (light pink)

Fat quarter of green #25121 (appliqué shapes and inner border corners)

3/4 yard hot pink #25121 (appliqué shapes, inner border and binding)

3/4 yard light blue #25126 (inner border)

1-1/2 yards blue/purple stripe (#25118) for outer border

Variiegated thread for machine appliqué ; 1 yard lightweight fusible web (I used Trans-Web)

3-1/2 yards backing; Batting at least 60" square (64" square if using a longarm specialist)

Tablet of newsprint - this is stabilizer for machine appliqué (costs about \$2 for a kid's scribble pad of 100 sheets)

Freezer paper for templates

Students are expected to know their sewing machines and to practice with some stitches at home before attending class. DO NOT COME WITH A BRAND NEW MACHINE YOU'VE NEVER USED. This is NOT FOR BEGINNERS.

Precutting strips for applique patches

-- Large feather top - 6" x 7" rectangle (total of 8)

-- Large feather in outer borders - 6" x 7" rectangle (total of 8)

-- Small feather bottom - 6" x 4" (total of 8)

-- Small feathers in outside four corners of big block - 6" x 4" (total of 4)

-- Center star - 5" square

*****If you want to transfer the fusible webbing to the wrong side of these patches (or whatever fabrics you use), go ahead and do it. This saves time in class. Please refer to manufacturer's directions.

Bring some of your background fabric to class; you will need some good size scraps for practice with your sm stitches. I will have samples of sm stitches sewn using actual Princess Feather patches.

1. Bring a zig zag foot or other similar foot that will enable you to stitch something other than the straight stitch. (You can sew with a straight stitch if you desire)
2. Bring the sewing machine you want to FINISH this quilt on. We will be doing some sewing in the class.
