

Rainbow Strips & Curves

Quilt #1 - Rainbow Curves



6 Hour Workshop with Debby Kratovil. Learn one quilt technique in the morning and the second one in the afternoon - a Two-for-One special! The leftovers from the Rainbow Curves provide the fabric needed for Rainbow Strips. (You can't finish both quilts in the day!)

Quilt #1 - Note the two different colorways. The Rainbow Quilt has 36 blocks, 6" x 6". The Black & White Quilt has 38 blocks AND 10 plain squares (cut 6-1/2") You can get 6 squares (6-1/2") from a 6-1/2" x 42" strip of fabric. you will need one cut 6" square for TWO of the photo corners. Plan accordingly.

Pre-cutting strips for QUILT #1 (remove selvages, giving you 40-42" of usable width) From each of the 12 colors cut the following: three 6-1/2" background squares and two 6" squares for the photo corners.

IF USING YOUR OWN SCRAPS: a total of (36) 6-1/2" squares (block backgrounds) and (12) 6" squares (for the 24 photo corners)

(24) 6" squares fusible interfacing. If you want to transfer this to the WRONG side of each of your (24) 6" squares, you can do that ahead of time. PLEASE READ MANUFACTURER'S DIRECTIONS. Protect your iron and ironing board cover. Don't melt the interfacing. THIS IS NOT PAPER BACKED FUSIBLE WEB!!

Quilt #2 - Rainbow Strips



Special Note for Quilt #2

Each set of 5 strips will yield
4 blocks
20 strips will yield 16 blocks
25 strips will yield 20 blocks

16 Blocks w/border
JELLY ROLL FRIENDLY!

20 Blocks w/border

This Quilt #2 is perfect for Jelly Roll packs. Debby will have a large supply of Jelly Rolls with 30 strips each, in a variety of colors and themes (ie, some in the black/browns, some novelty, some brights, etc). This will get you started immediately!

Pre-cutting strips for QUILT #2 (DO NOT remove selvages)

(2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips from EACH of the 12 different fabrics (24 strips)

IF USING YOUR OWN SCRAPS: a total of (20-25) 2-1/2" x 42" strips - they don't have to all be different.

You can use any colors you desire; both quilts can use different colorways
The following is a GUIDE for colors

Materials You Will Need for both quilts...

1/2 yard EACH of 12 different colors for the blocks OR YOUR OWN SCRAPS - SEE BELOW

3/4 - 1 yard fabric for border and binding for QUILT #1 (can be purchased at a later date)

3/4 - 1 yard fabric for border and binding for QUILT #2 (can be purchased at a later date)

2 yards lightweight fusible interfacing for QUILT #1 - DO NOT PURCHASE WONDER UNDER OR ANY FUSIBLE WEB

Thread for machine appliqué (I selected one color - orange - to use throughout my quilt) - QUILT #1

Freezer paper (2-3 sheets, notebook size) - QUILT #1

12-1/2" square acrylic ruler; other rulers

Scissors, rotary cutter, mat - all Basic Sewing supplies (these are sewing machine classes)

Tablet of newsprint (can find in grocery stores, office supply - cheap tablets for kids)
