Tessellations - Interlocking Stars (3 Hour Class)

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All Skill Levels. Sewing Machine Class

The **Tessellating Star** pattern is a variation on the Railfence block. With the addition of a two-part central log sliced on the diagonal, composed of two colors, when these blocks are set side by side they create a fascinating illusion of the complex as the stars interlock.

Our **CLASS PROJECT** will be to sew four 12" blocks of a two-color quilt, with borders added if time permits.

SUPPLY LIST:

- 1/2 yard each of two fabrics with strong contrast (see quilt example in red and gold to the left)
- 3/4 yard border print to coordinate with first two fabrics
- optional 1-1/2" strip of two coordinating prints for inner borders
- sewing machine in good working order
- neutral colored thread
- rotary cutter, ruler, mat; scissors and straight pins; #2 sharpened pencil.

Pre-cutting strips ahead of class (optional):

(5) 2-1/2" x wof (width of fabric) from **EACH** of the two colors (my quilt uses red and gold print)

This is a sewing machine class which assumes student is familiar with the sewing machine she brings to class. If in doubt, practice sewing 1/4" seams on scraps at home. This is very beginner friendly, but assumes that student knows how to use a sewing machine and sew a straight line with a 1/4" seam. Bring all cutting supplies, scissors, thread, as well as extra sewing machine needles.



Two Color Class Project
