How Much is that Doggie in the Window?



PROJECT RATING:

Easy

Size: 38" × 41¼"

Blocks: 9 (10") blocks

QUILT BY **Debby Kratovil**.

These adorable pups will charm children of all ages.

MATERIALS

Crib-size quilt batting

*fat quarter = $18" \times 20"$

¾ yard dog print
1¼ yards border print
¾ yard black print
1 fat quarter* aqua stripe
1 fat quarter* aqua print
½ yard orange print for blocks and binding
¾ yard yellow print
1¼ yards backing fabric

NOTE: Fabrics in the quilt shown are from the Playful Pups collection by Benartex.

Cutting

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Border strips are exact length needed. You may want to make them longer to allow for piecing variations.

From dog print, cut:

 5 (8¼") A squares, centering 4 dogs in each.

From dog section of border print, cut:

• 1 (7¾"-wide) **lengthwise** strip, centering dogs and flowers. From strip, cut 1 (7¾" × 38½") bottom border.

From Love My Dog section of border print, cut:

• 1 (4½"-wide) **lengthwise** strip, centering words. From strip, cut 1 $(4\frac{1}{2}" \times 38\frac{1}{2}")$ top border.

From black print, cut:

• 1 (10½"-wide) strip. From strip, cut 4 (10½" \times 7½") C rectangles.

From aqua stripe fat quarter, cut:

 4 (3½"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 4 (3½" × 10½") D rectangles.

From agua print fat guarter, cut:

• 5 (2¾"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 5 (2¾" \times 12") B rectangles.

From orange print, cut:


- 2 (2 $\frac{3}{4}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 5 (2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " × 12") B rectangles.
- 5 (21/4"-wide) strips for binding.

From yellow print, cut:


• 2 ($4\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 2 ($4\frac{1}{2}$ " \times 30½") side borders.

Block Assembly

1. Join 1 aqua print B rectangle, 1 orange print B rectangle, and 1 dog print A square as shown in Block Assembly Diagram. Miter corner to complete 1 Block 1 (Block 1 Diagram). Make 5 Block 1.

2. Join 1 black print C rectangle and 1 aqua stripe D rectangle as shown in Block 2 Diagram .Make 4 Block 2.





Quilt Assembly


- 1. Lay out blocks as shown inQuilt Top Assembly Diagram Join into rows; join rows to complete quilt center.
- **2.** Add yellow print side borders to quilt center.
- **3.** Add Love My Dog border to top of quilt.
- 4. Add dog border to bottom of quilt.

Finishing

- 1. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired. Quilt shown was quilted in the ditch around blocks, with meandering loops in rectangles and side borders, and outline quilting around dogs (Quilting Diagram).
- 3. Join 2¼"-wide orange print strips into 1 continuous piece for straight-grain French-fold binding. Add binding to quilt.
