



Make one copy to keep as your master pattern and make one copy to sew on. If you photocopy this pattern, use a ruler to make sure that the copy machine has not altered the size. This is pieced in 1 continuous section, much like a Log Cabin block. I have included the word "background" to aid in fabric placement. Patches 2, 3, 6, 7, 10 & 11 are all for the Palm fabric color. Multiple copies allowed for ONE USER ONLY.

Cut 2-1/2" wide strips of BOTH the background and palm leaf colors. Stitch the patches in numerical order using the strips; trim, press, add the next strip in sequence. 1/4" seam allowance on outside edges allows for trimming the block when you are finished piecing. Gently remove papers, supporting the beginnings of the seams as you do so.
