Fabric Requirements:

Denim Version

Fabric A: 2 yds of 5381 Ivory
Fabric B: 1/2 yd of 5680 Rust
Fabric C: 1-1/4 yd 5680 Denim
Fabric D: 1/2 yd of 5677 Denim
Fabric E: 1/2 yd of 5676 Ivory
Fabric F: 5/8 yd of 5679 Hay
Fabric G: 5/8 yd of 5381 Clay
Fabric H: 1/8 yd of 3955 Jet
Fabric I: 1/2 yd of M3708 Cactus
Fabric J: 2 yds of 5675 Denim
Fabric K: 6-1/4 yds of 5678 Clay (includes backing)
1-1/2 yd paper backed fusible webbing
Thread to match Fabrics B, D and I
Template Material for boots and cactus

Tan Version

Fabric A: 2 yds of 5381 Ivory
Fabric B: 1/2 yd of 5680 Cocoa
Fabric C: 1-1/4 yd 5680 Denim
Fabric D: 1/2 yd of 5677 Ivory
Fabric E: 1/2 yd of 5676 Tan
Fabric F: 5/8 yd of 5679 Hay
Fabric G: 5/8 yd of 5381 Clay
Fabric H: 1/8 yd of 3955 Jet
Fabric I: 1/2 yd of M3708 Cactus
Fabric J: 2 yds of 5675 Tan
Fabric K: 6-1/4 yds of 5678 Clay (includes backing)
1-1/2 yd paper backed fusible webbing
Thread to match Fabrics B, D and I
Template Material for boots and cactus

Cutting Directions: (Note: WOF indicates cutting across the width of fabric)

Fabric A: Cut 13 squares 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" for appliqué background; cut 20 squares 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" for checked borders.

Fabric B: Cut 6 rectangles 7-1/2" x 9-1/2". Fuse wrong side of each with paper backed webbing and allow to cool.
Use Template A on page 4 to cut out 6 of the main boot pattern.

Fabric C: Cut four 3-1/2" x WOF strips; recut into 40 squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"; set aside for border. Also cut 6 rectangles 1" x 4-1/2" for Template B and 6 rectangles 3" x 4-1/2" for Template C on page 4. Fuse wrong side of each with paper backed webbing and allow to cool. Use appropriate templates to cut out 6 each of the two template shapes. Cut 9 strips 2-1/4" x WOF for use as binding.

Fabric D: Cut 6 squares 8-1/2" x 8-1/2".

Fabric E: Cut 6 squares 8-1/2" x 8-1/2".

Fabric F: Cut 12 strips 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" and 12 strips 2-1/2" x 12-1/2".

Fabric G: Cut 12 strips 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" and 12 strips 2-1/2" x 12-1/2".

Fabric H: Cut 6 of Template D and 6 of Template E on page 4. Transfer fusible webbing to the wrong side of each patch.

Fabric I: Cut 7 rectangles 6" x 12". Fuse wrong side of each rectangle with paper backed webbing and allow to cool; transfer Template F on page 5 (Cactus) markings and cut out.

Fabric J: Cut 8 strips 8" x WOF; these will be pieced and trimmed to fit for the borders later.

Fabric K: Cut 2 strips 3-1/2" x WOF; recut into 20 squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2".

Block Assembly Instructions and diagrams on following page.

Block Assembly:

Denim Version:

- 1a. Sew the Fabric D squares with the Fabric F strips as shown in Diagram 1.
Sew the Fabric E squares with the Fabric G strips as shown.
Make 6 blocks as shown in Diagram 1.

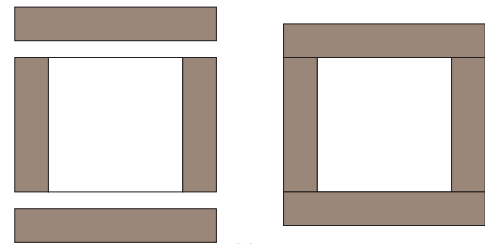

Tan Version:

- 1b. Sew the Fabric D squares with the Fabric G strips and the Fabric E squares with the Fabric F strips. Make 6 blocks as shown in Diagram 1.

2. Remove the paper from the back of the appliqué templates; center the Boot templates in the center of each of the Fabric A squares and fuse in place. Using matching thread and a zigzag sewing machine stitch, sew in place. Make 6 of these Boot blocks (Diagram 2).

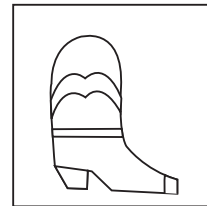

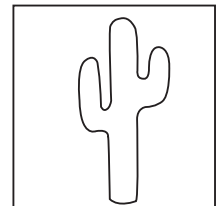
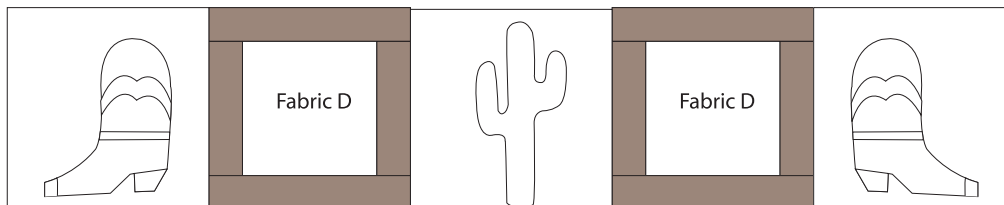


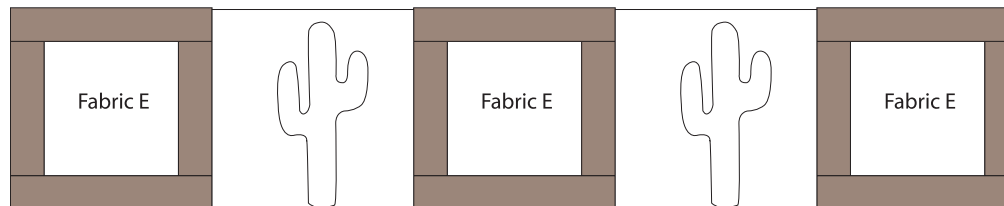

NOTE: 3 of the boots face to the left and 3 of the boots face to the right. Repeat for the Cactus blocks, making seven (Diagram 3).

3. Sew the quilt center together as shown in the color picture, alternating the blocks as shown. Refer to the Row Assembly Diagrams.



Rows 1, 3 and 5



Rows 2 and 4

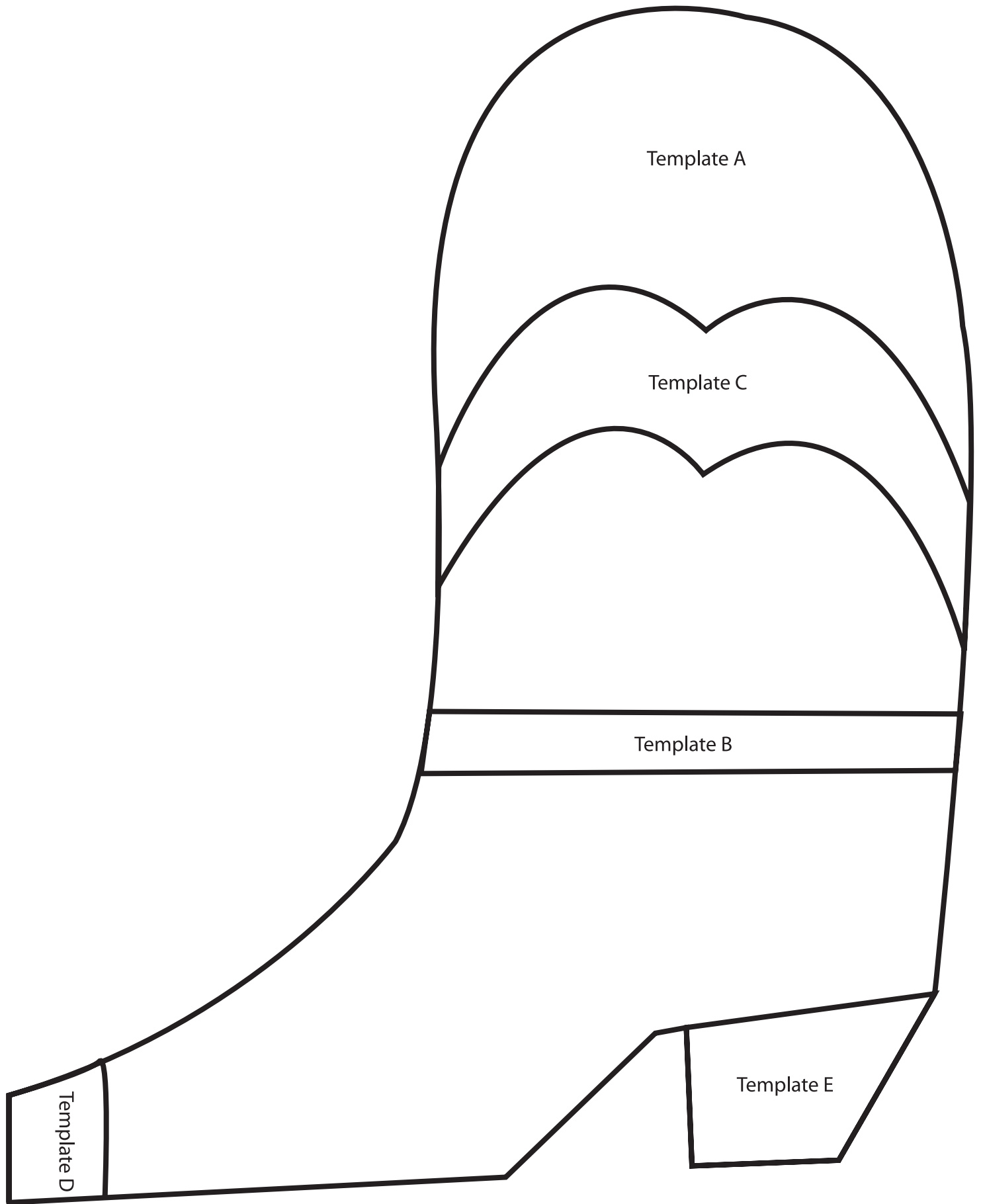
4. Sew the Fabric A, C and J 3-1/2" squares into the two checked border rows as shown. Sew one row to quilt top and one to quilt bottom. Press seams well. Quilt center now measures 60-1/2" x 72-1/2". Refer to the quilt assembly diagram on page 6 for placement. (Adjust the following cutting directions to correspond with the measurements of your own quilt center.)



Checked Inner Border - Make 2

5. Sew two Fabric K strips together along the short ends; repeat. Trim these two long border strips to 72-1/2" in length and sew to quilt sides.
6. Sew two Fabric K strips together along the short ends; repeat. Trim these two long border strips to 76-1/2" and sew to quilt top and bottom.
7. Layer and quilt as desired.
8. Piece together the nine 2-1/4" Fabric C strips and use for binding.

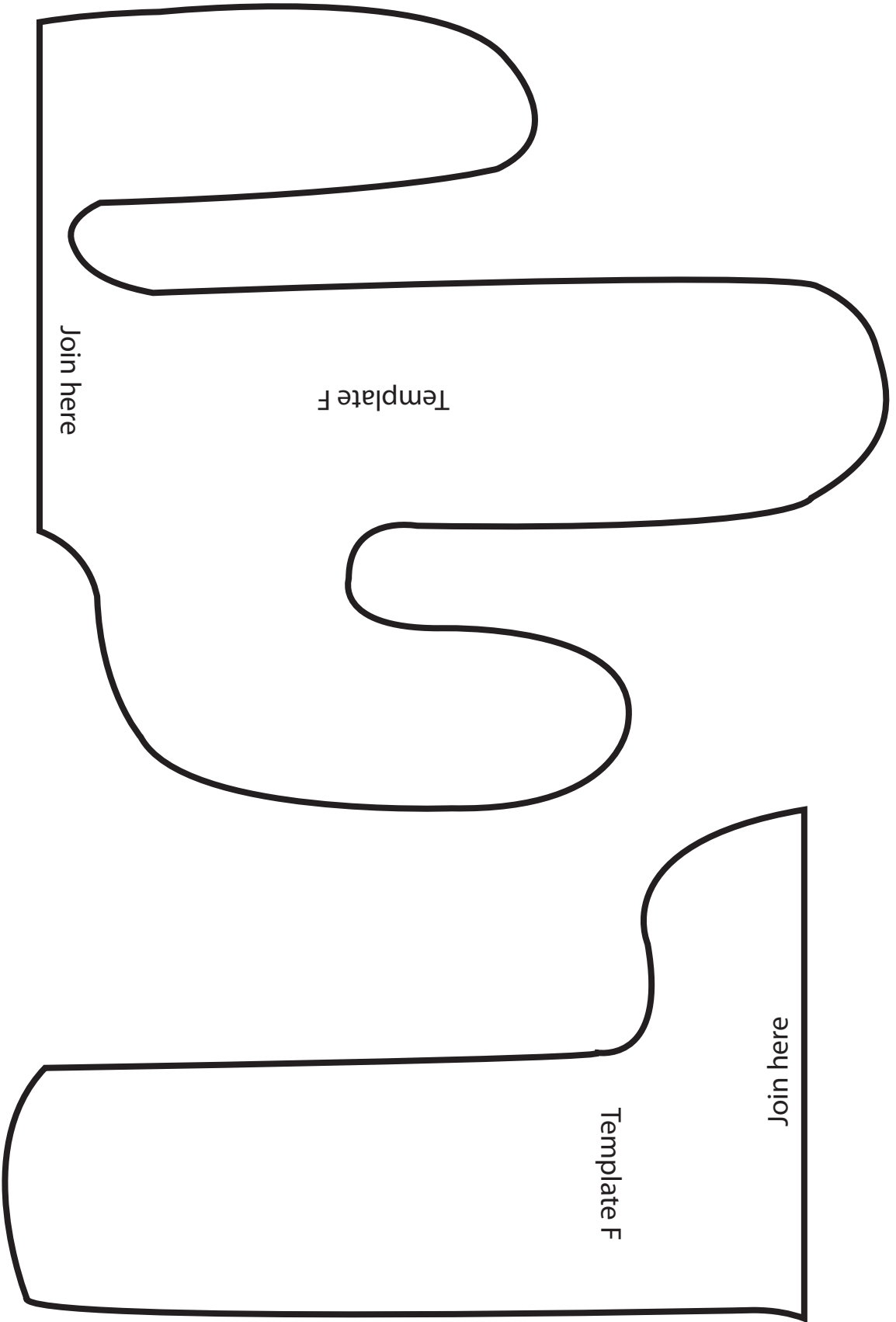

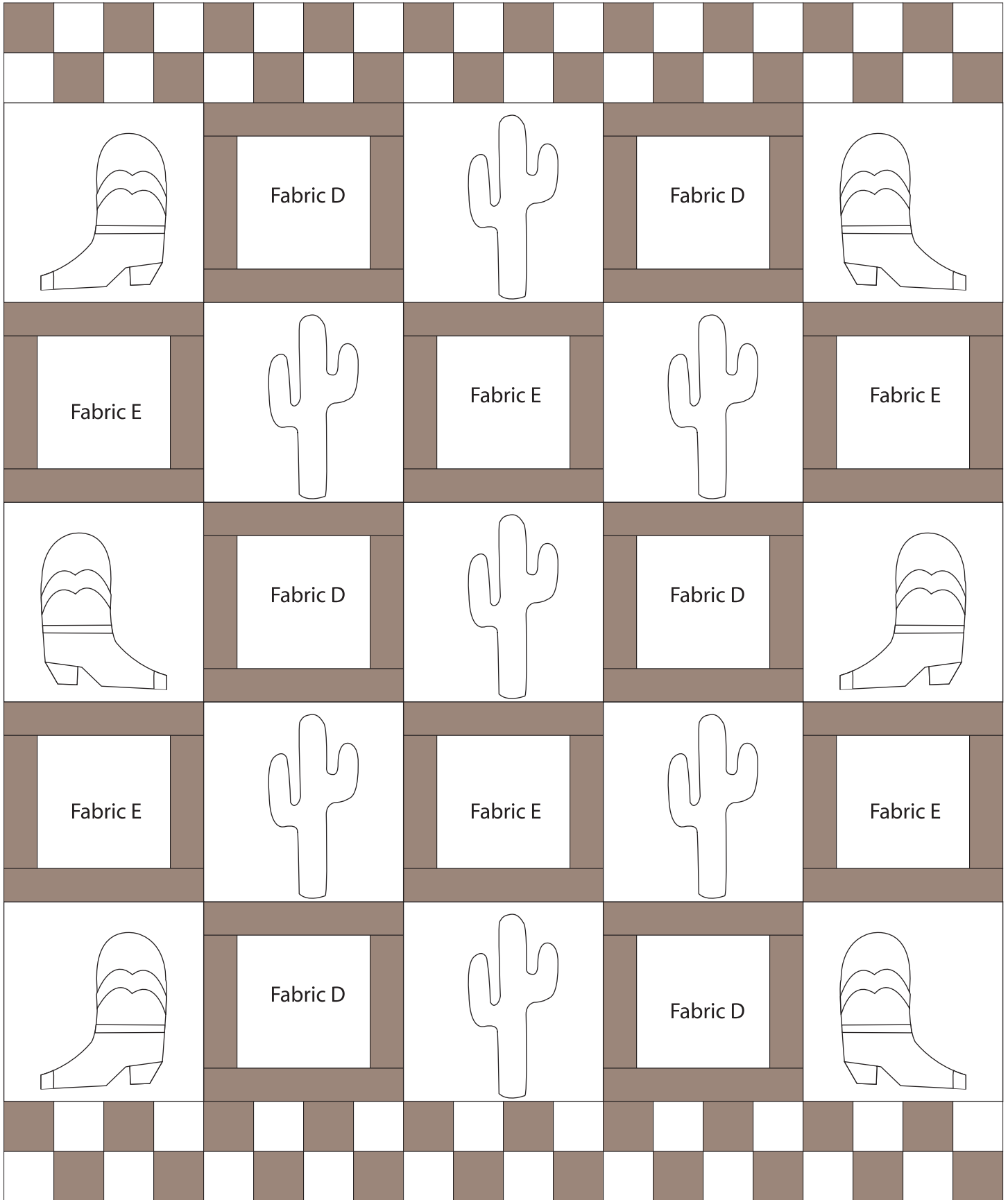
