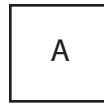


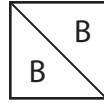

Finished block is mirror image of paper piecing pattern

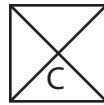

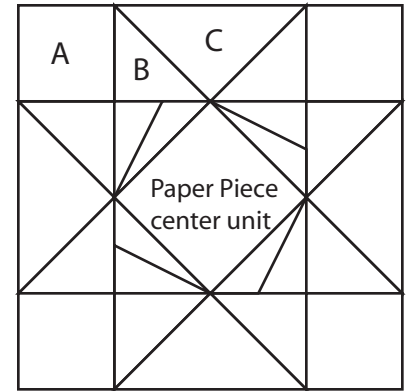
Cut (4) 3-1/2" squares black



Cut (1) 3-7/8" square red, green, purple & orange; recut each into two triangles

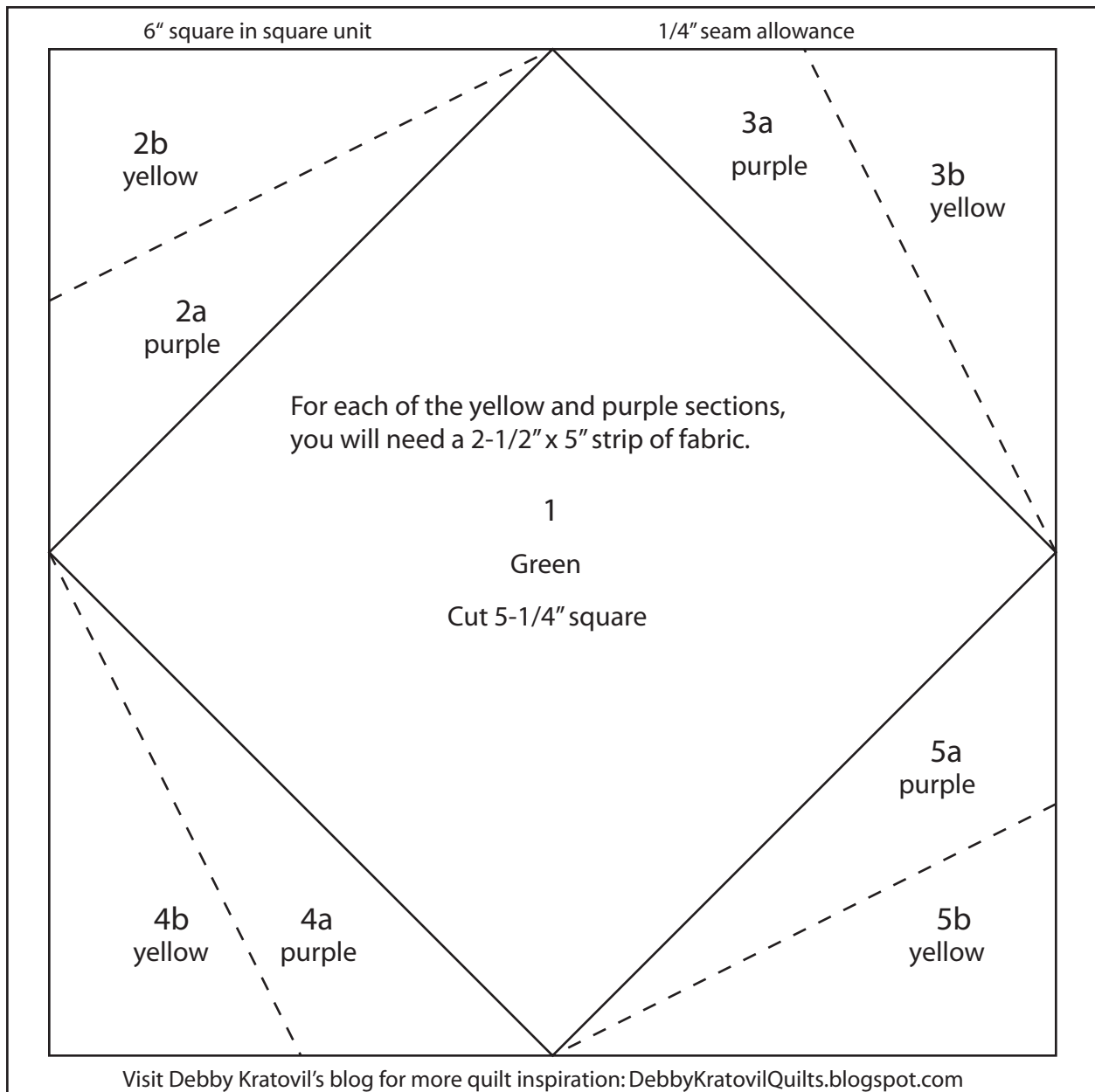


Cut (1) 7-1/4" square black; recut into 4 triangles

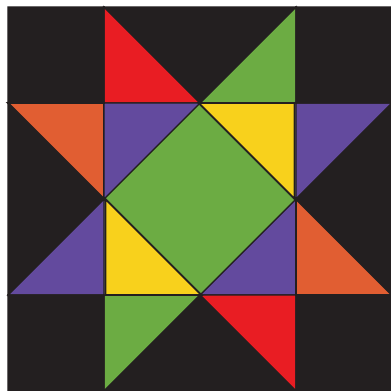


12" x 12" finished

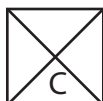

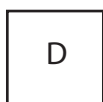
Cut (4) 3-1/2" squares black



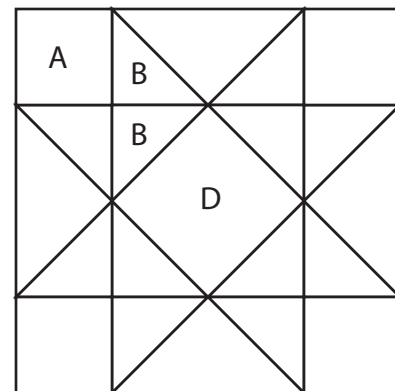
Cut (1) 3-7/8" square red,  
(1) green, (2) purple  
and (1) orange;  
recut each into two triangles



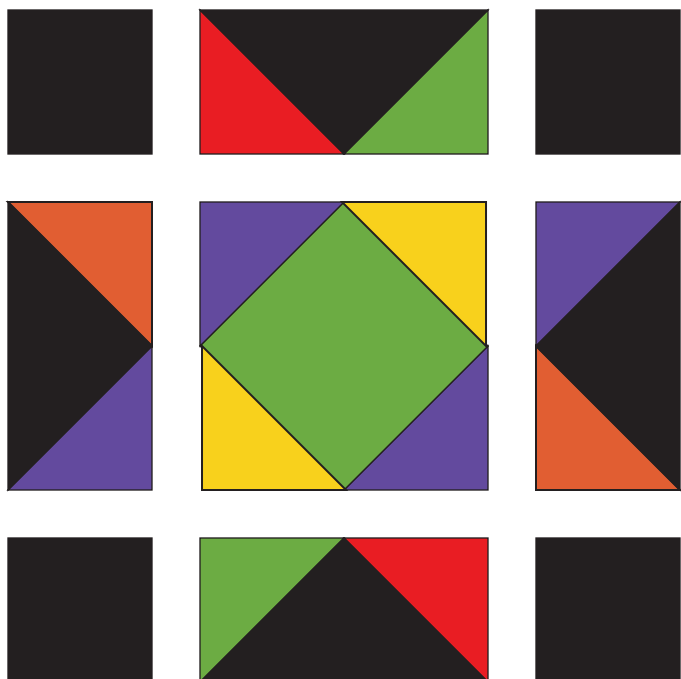
Cut (1) 7-1/4" square black;  
recut into 4 triangles



Cut (1) 4-3/4" squares green



12" x 12" finished



Piecing Sequence:

Sew the center Square in Square unit.  
Press seams toward triangles.

Make the 4 Flying Geese star points using  
the Black C triangles and the colored B triangles.

Press seams toward the small B triangles.

Join the units into 3 horizontal rows.

Join the 3 horizontal rows into the block.

Evening Star is 12-1/2" unfinished; 12" finished.
