

12" Royal Star Block

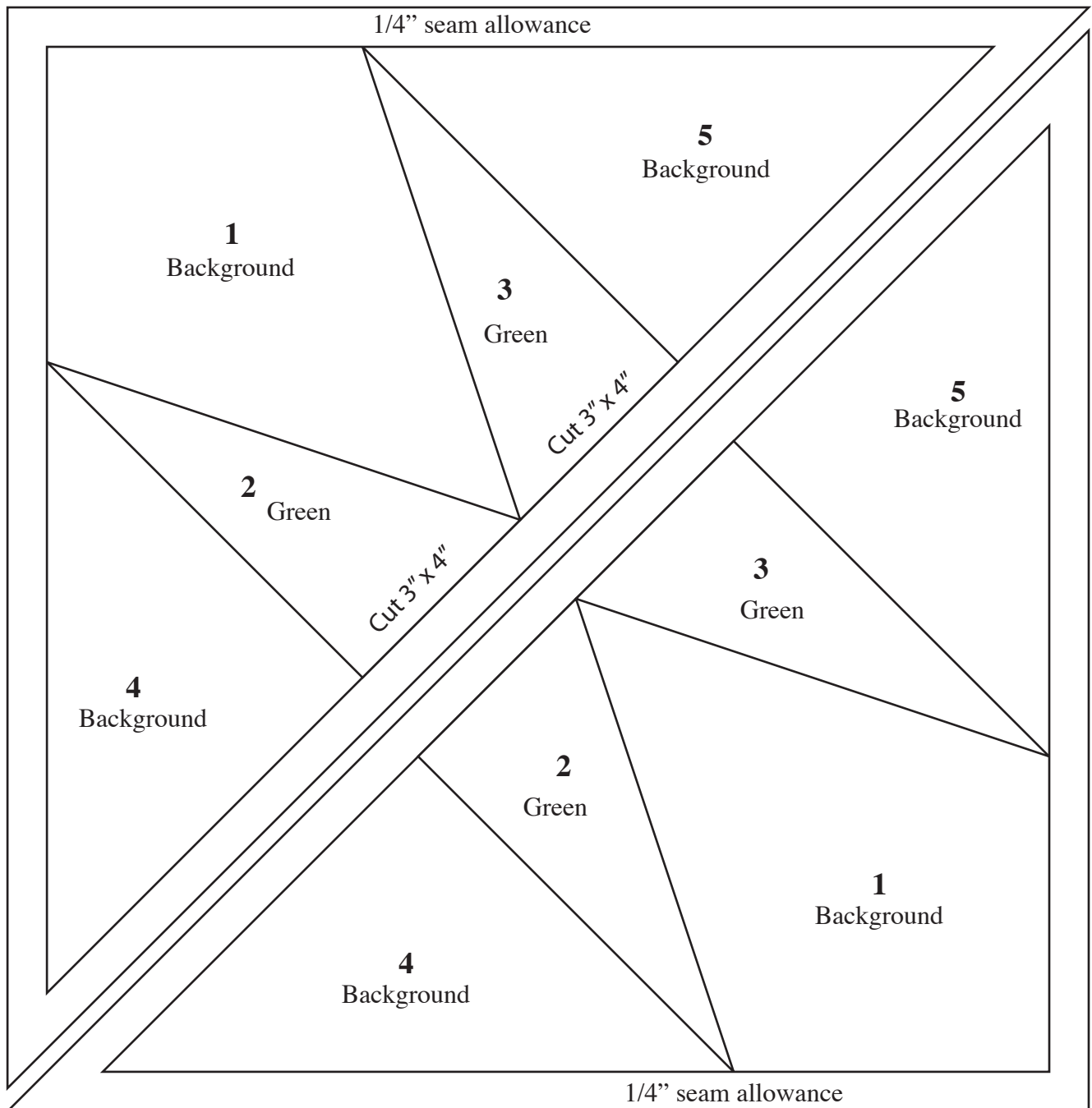
Galaxy of Stars Quilt

Make a total of four copies of the star points units below. We've included quick cutting hints for oversized patches for each of the sections.

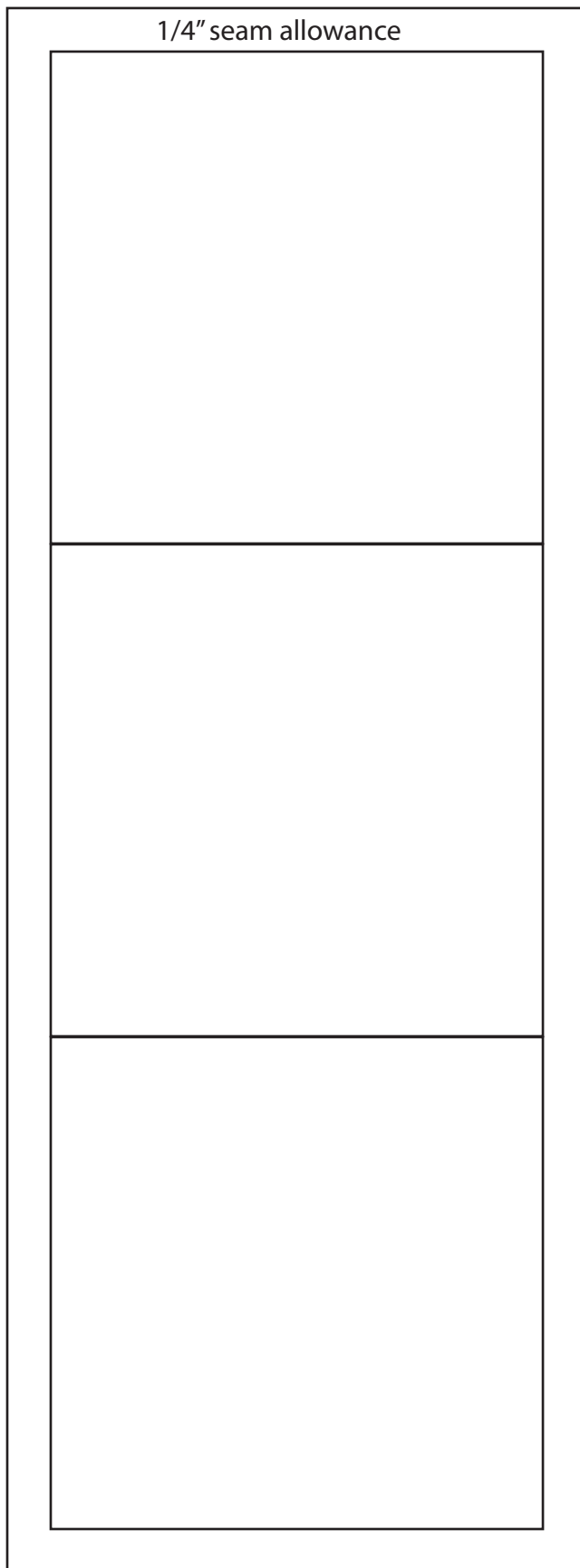
For patches 4 & 5, cut a 6" square into 4 triangles each.

For the star points, Patches #1 & 2, cut 3" x 4" strips

'For Patch #1, cut a 4" square



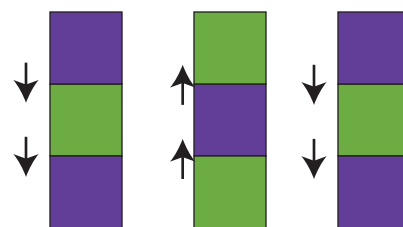
12" Royal Star - center Nine Patch
Make 3 copies of the pattern below



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Cut nine 3-3/4" squares for center 9-Patch
4 green squares to match star point fabric
5 squares of purple
Use squares for foundation piecing
the three units below.
Make 3 rows as shown.



NOTE: The pressing direction is important.
The paper foundation unit is NOT numbered
so that you can begin at either end, according
to the fabric swatch. This assists in making the
seams nestle/butt against each other for a
clean seam juncture.
