Are you ready to reach for the stars?

This Galaxy of Stars quilt will give you a great opportunity to try a lot of different piecing techniques, a great way to use up scraps, and provide a finished quilt fit for a bed (80" x 80").!

Take it one block at a time. First comes the supply list (right here, right now). Then, beginning in January 2015, I will provide one FREE pattern a month, so you can pace yourself.

There are twelve 12" blocks, four 6" supporting blocks, and one giant 24" center block to complete. Beginning in the late Spring 2015, I will give you an extra block here and there so you can complete this by the end of the year.

Please know there will be NO resizing of any blocks offered. Blocks will be available throughout 2015. I also cannot recalculate yardages to accommodate your own color selections. And if you are not comfortable with paper piecing, just make two of another rotary cut block. You can make any substitutions you wish!

Yardages based on the colors I used above:

- Black Dot (the main background fabric): 1-1/2 yards (or select any color you wish)
- Orange, Purple and Green fabrics: 1 yard EACH
- Red: 2 to 2-1/2 yards (includes sashing and border cornerstone blocks)
- Yellow: 3/4 yard (includes 2-1/2" sashing cornerstones)
- Outer Border and Binding: 2-1/4 yards large dot on black (or your choosing)
- 6 yards backing; queen sized batting

***It's always wise to buy a little more than indicated to allow for any "bad" cuts.

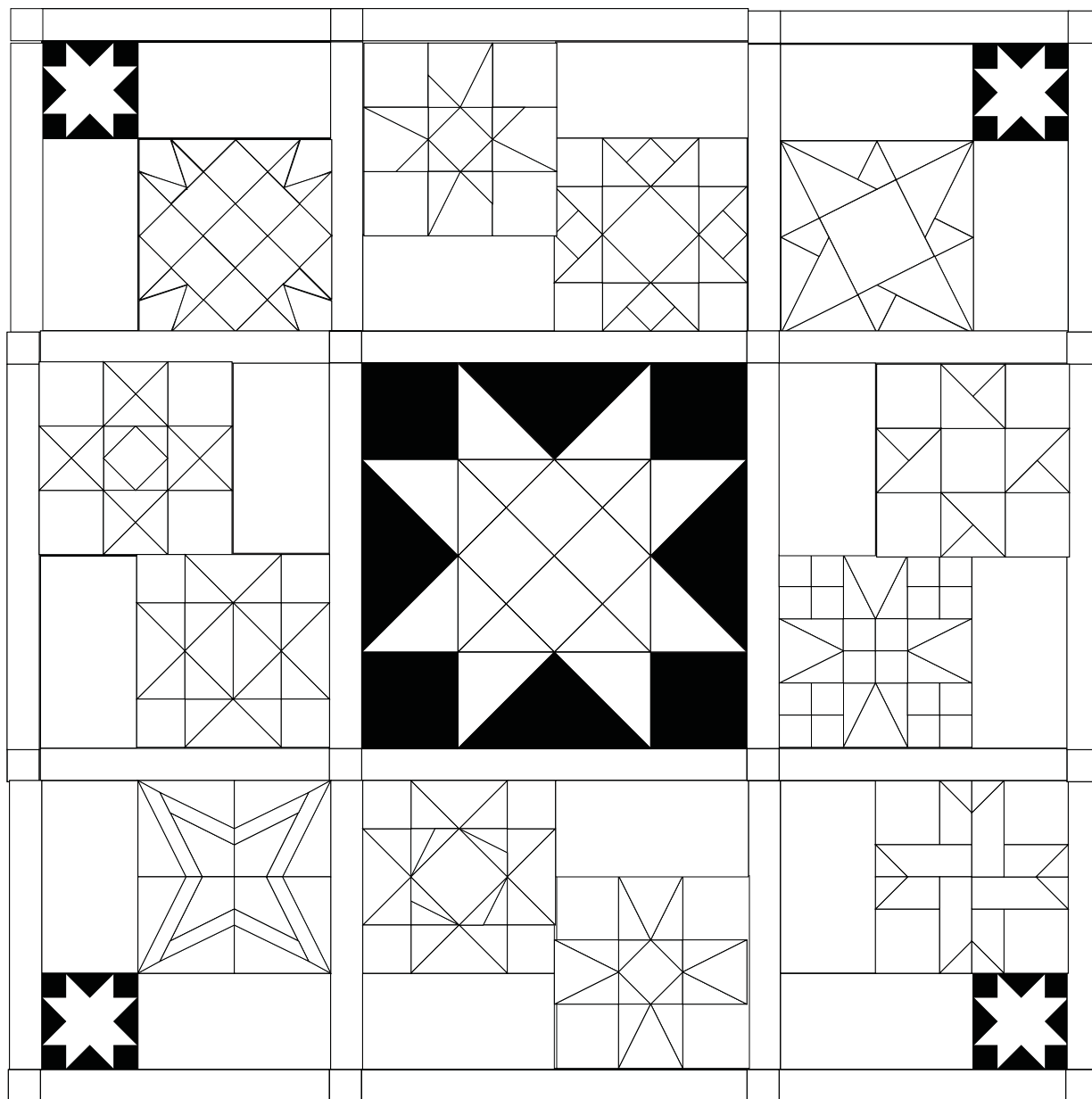
