

Diamond Head Quilt by Debby Kratovil



Quilt Size - 52" x 52"
Block Size: 17"

Using only pre-cut strips, paper piecing this block is a breeze! The center is the traditional LeMoyne Star variation, which is paper pieced. The corner triangles are added to set it on point. It is easy to get those REALLY sharp points using my pattern and the foundation piecing technique.

Students will learn:

- Easy steps to confident paper piecing
- Tips on the best paper to use
- How to make multiple copies using your sewing machine - not a copier!
- Various settings for multiple blocks (I will have other sample quilts)
- Other fun blocks to create using the basic unit

Supply List:

- 1/2 yard EACH of two colors for the paper pieced blocks
- 1/3 yard EACH of two colors for the corner triangles (see ***NOTE below)
- 1/4 yard stripe (or other preferred fabric) for inner border
- 2 yards fabric for border AND binding
- Tablet of newsprint for making patterns (Kroger's, Target, Michaels as a source)
- Add-a-Quarter ruler (6" or 12")
- Sewing machine in GOOD working order. DO NOT bring a machine you've not sewn on before or in a long time.
- Rulers, rotary cutter, scissors, pencil, thread, etc

*****NOTE:** You will need (4) 9-3/4" squares of each of the fabrics noted above for the corner triangles to set the stars on point. If you are not able to get these from ONE single strip (9-3/4" x 42/44") of your fabric, you will need to buy 5/8 yard.

Pre-cutting strips for the paper piecing:

- Begin with TWO 3" x 42/44" strips of EACH of your two selected fabrics for the center LeMoyne Star. We will cut more later.
