



Sassy, Scrappy Dogwood Blossoms
Designed and made by Debby Kratovil

Technique: Paper Piecing Block Size: 7"
Number of Blocks in Quilt: 12
Quilt Size: 31-1/2" x 38-1/2"

Not recommended for beginners. Must have basic sewing and quilting skills.

Materials You Will Need...

Fat 1/8 or 1/4 EACH of: pink, purple, magenta, yellow, green and blue bright fabrics
1/2 yard butterscotch for background of block points
1/4 yard EACH of two multi-print fabrics for block background
1/4 yard hot pink for inner border
1/2 yard blue dot for outer border
1/3 yard stripe for binding *** Invisible nylon thread for machine top stitching ***
Tablet of newsprint (available at grocery and crafts stores). I will have some available.
I provide all patterns and instructions to make this quilt.

This is a sewing machine class. Please be familiar with your machine before bringing it to class.
Rotary cutter, mat, rulers, scissors, neutral sewing thread, pencil and all basic sewing supplies are expected.

Precutting strips is helpful: For BOTH the Dogwood Blossom points, AND the orange background cut strips
2-1/2" x 3-1/2". Cut 7-1/2" strip of floral block background print. The 1/4 circles are cut from 4-1/2" squares.
