Learn to paper piece with confidence. Discover how simple it is using Debby's 10" Palm Leaf block. Using only pre-cut strips, paper piecing this block is a breeze! There is only one section - much like a Log Cabin block. We will focus on making one block - which can be turned into a pillow with flange. The option of one pattern (including all foundation piecing patterns) from the other samples will be available for a fee.

Students will learn:

- Easy steps to confident paper piecing
- How to make multiple copies using your sewing machine - not a copier!
- Tips on the best paper to use
- How to turn any block into a pillow with flange

Supply List for one block pillow:

- 1/4 yard EACH of two fabrics with good contrast for the Palm block
- 1/4 yard print for setting block on point (mine uses a black floral)
- 3/4 yard for pillow flange and back of pillow (mine uses a stripe)
- Add-a-Quarter ruler (6" or 12")
- 21" square of thin batting (can be purchased at a later time; I will have samples)
- 14" pillow form (can be purchased at a later time)
- Sewing machine in GOOD working order. DO NOT bring a machine you've not sewn on before or in a long time.
- Rulers, rotary cutter, scissors, pencil, thread, etc
- **I supply** the large format pattern for piecing

Pre-cutting strips for the paper piecing

Background

- (1) 3-1/4" square
- (2) 3-1/4" x 6-1/2" strips
- (2) 3-1/4" x 9" strips
- (2) 3-1/4" x 11-1/4" strips

Palm

- (1) 3-1/4" square
- (2) 3-1/4" x 6" strips
- (1) 3-1/4" x 8" strip
- (1) 3-1/4" x 8-1/2" strip
- (1) 3-1/4" x 11" strip
