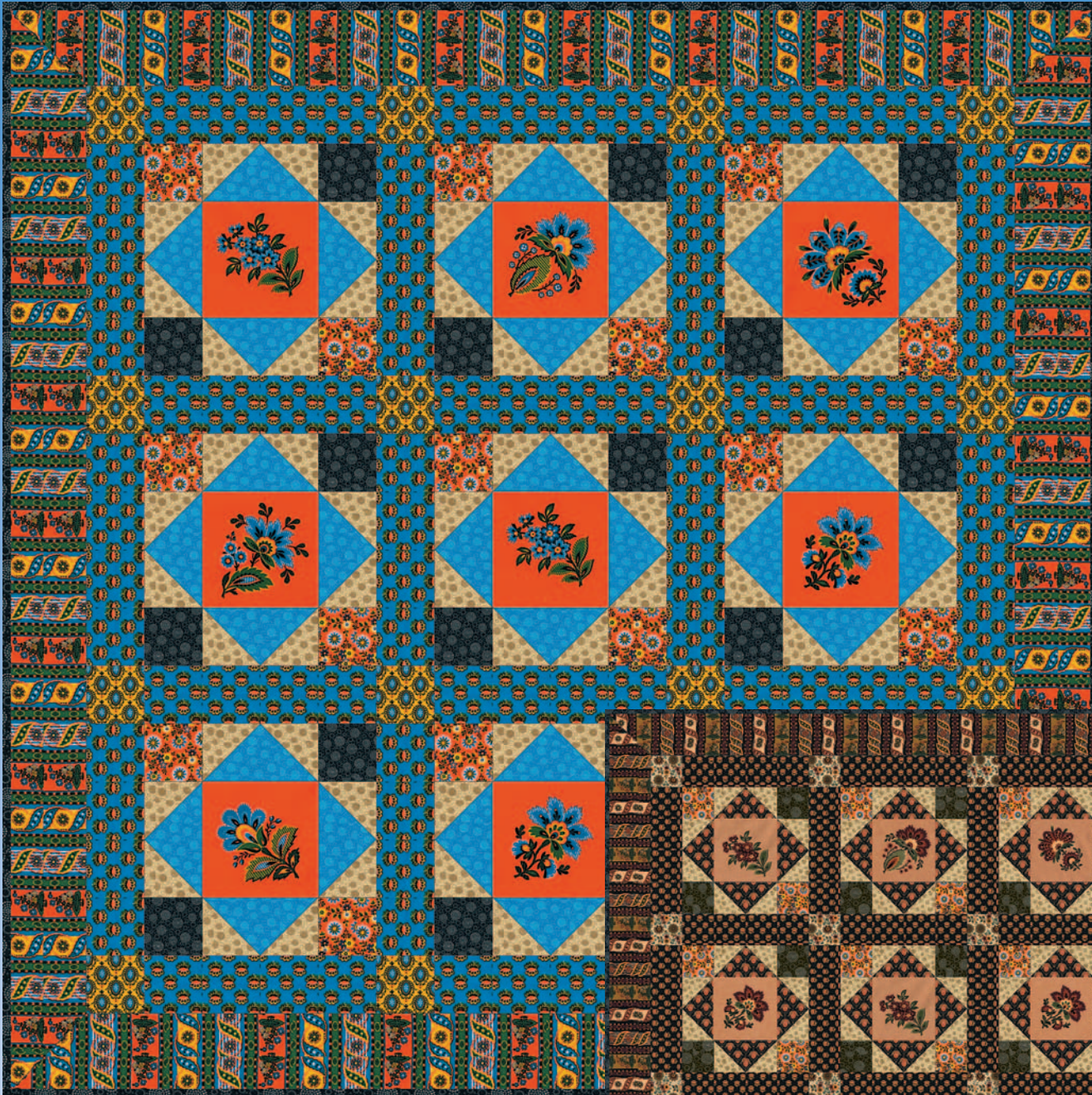
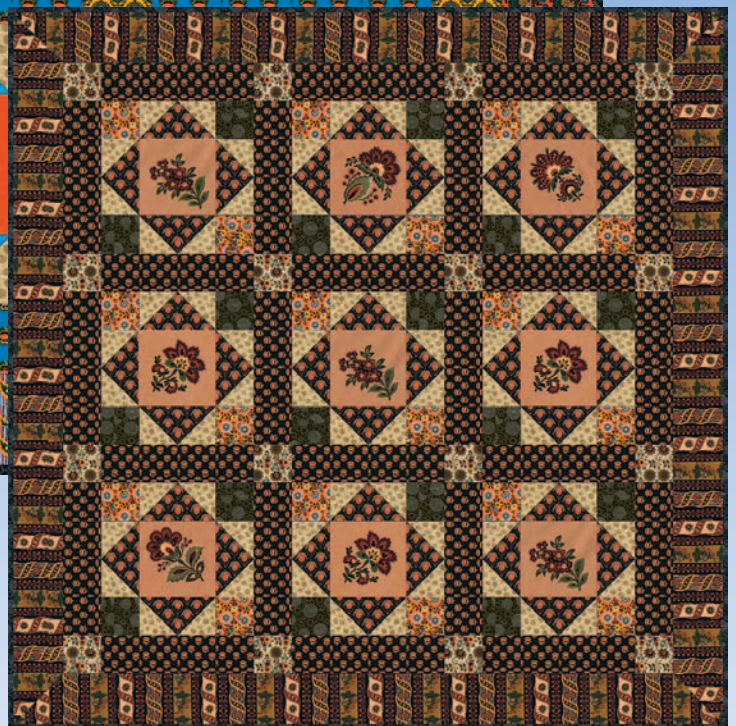

Finished Size: 54" x 54"
Block Size: 12"

Fabric Requirements:

Orange Version

Fabric A: 1 yd of 5214 Orange
Fabric B: 1/2 yd of 5217 Orange
Fabric C: 1/2 yd of 5212 Turquoise
Fabric D: 1/4 yd of 5213 Orange
Fabric E: 3/4 yd of 5212 Black
Fabric F: 1/2 yd of 5212 Ivory
Fabric G: 1/4 yd of 5215 Lemon
Fabric H: 3/4 yd of 5216 Turquoise
Fabric I: 3 yds of 5211 Green

Spice Version

Fabric A: 1 yd of 5214 Spice
Fabric B: 1/2 yd of 5217 Camel
Fabric C: 1/2 yd of 5215 Black
Fabric D: 1/4 yd of 5213 Orange
Fabric E: 3/4 yd of 5212 Black
Fabric F: 1/2 yd of 5212 Ivory
Fabric G: 1/4 yd of 5213 Ivory
Fabric H: 3/4 yd of 5216 Black
Fabric I: 3 yds of 5211 Sienna

Cutting Directions:

Fabric A: Cut 6 strips 5" x 42" for borders (these will be pieced to reach the required 55" width)

Fabric B: Center selected flower within a 6-1/2" square for each of nine 6-1/2" squares

Fabric C: Cut 9 squares 7-1/4" x 7-1/4"; recut each into four triangles for a total of 36

Fabric D: Cut 18 squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"

Fabric E: Cut 18 squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"; cut 6 strips 2-1/8" x wof (binding)

Fabric F: Cut 36 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8"; recut each into two triangles for a total of 72

Fabric G: Cut 16 squares 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" (sashing squares)

Fabric H: Cut 24 strips 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" (sashings)

Sewing the Blocks:

1. Sew a Fabric F triangle to each side of a Fabric C triangle (Diagram 1). Make 36 of these Flying Geese units.
2. Sew a Fabric D square to the left side of a Flying Geese unit and a Fabric E square to the right side (see Diagram 2). Press seams toward the squares. Make 16 of these units.
3. Sew a Flying Geese unit from Step 1 to each of two opposing sides of a Fabric B square. Press seams toward the center square. Make 9 of these block centers.
4. Complete the King's Crown block by sewing a Flying Geese/Squares unit from Step 2 to the remaining two block sides (see Diagram 3). Make 9 King's Crown Blocks.

Sewing the Sashings:

5. Sew four Fabric H rectangles with three King's Crown blocks, beginning and ending with the Fabric H rectangles. Press seams toward the sashing rectangles (Diagram 4). Make three of these block rows.
6. Sew four Fabric G squares with three Fabric H strips, beginning and ending with the Fabric G squares (Diagram 5). Make four of these sashing rows.

Quilt Assembly:

7. Sew the 3 block rows with the 4 sashing rows, beginning and ending with the sashing rows.
8. Seam together the Fabric A border strips to equal 55" in length. Make four of these. Sew to sides, mitering the corners.
9. Using Fabric I, piece together the back to measure at least 58" x 58".
10. Layer quilt top, batting and quilt back. Quilt as desired.
11. Piece together the six 2-1/8" Fabric E strips and use for binding.

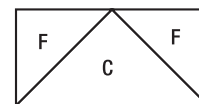
