Here we go again! Quilt blocks are their happiest when they find their way into a quilt. This January block, Birthday Cake, is perfect for all your celebrations throughout the year.



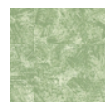
Birthday Cake Quilt - 46" x 46" Block Size: 12"



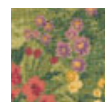
Fabric A  
1/2 yard



Fabric B  
5/8 yard



Fabric C  
5/8 yard



Fabric D  
1-1/2 yards  
(includes binding)

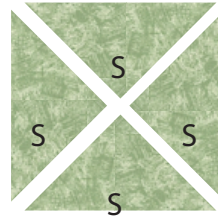
Birthday Cake Quilt by Debby Kratovil

 January 15    12" Block    46" x 46" Quilt

Basic Directions

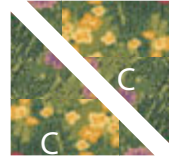
Cut borders FIRST, as follows:

- 2 pink horizontal strips 1-1/2" x 34-1/2"
- 2 pink vertical strips 1-1/2" x 36-1/2"
- 2 floral horizontal strips 5-1/2" x 36-1/2"
- 2 floral vertical strips 5-1/2" x 46-1/2" (use remainder from horizontal strips above; piece to get width)

Cut 1 green 18-1/4" square as shown to the right  
 Cut two floral 9-3/8" squares as shown to the right  
 Also cut ONE 12-1/2" square pink (quilt center)



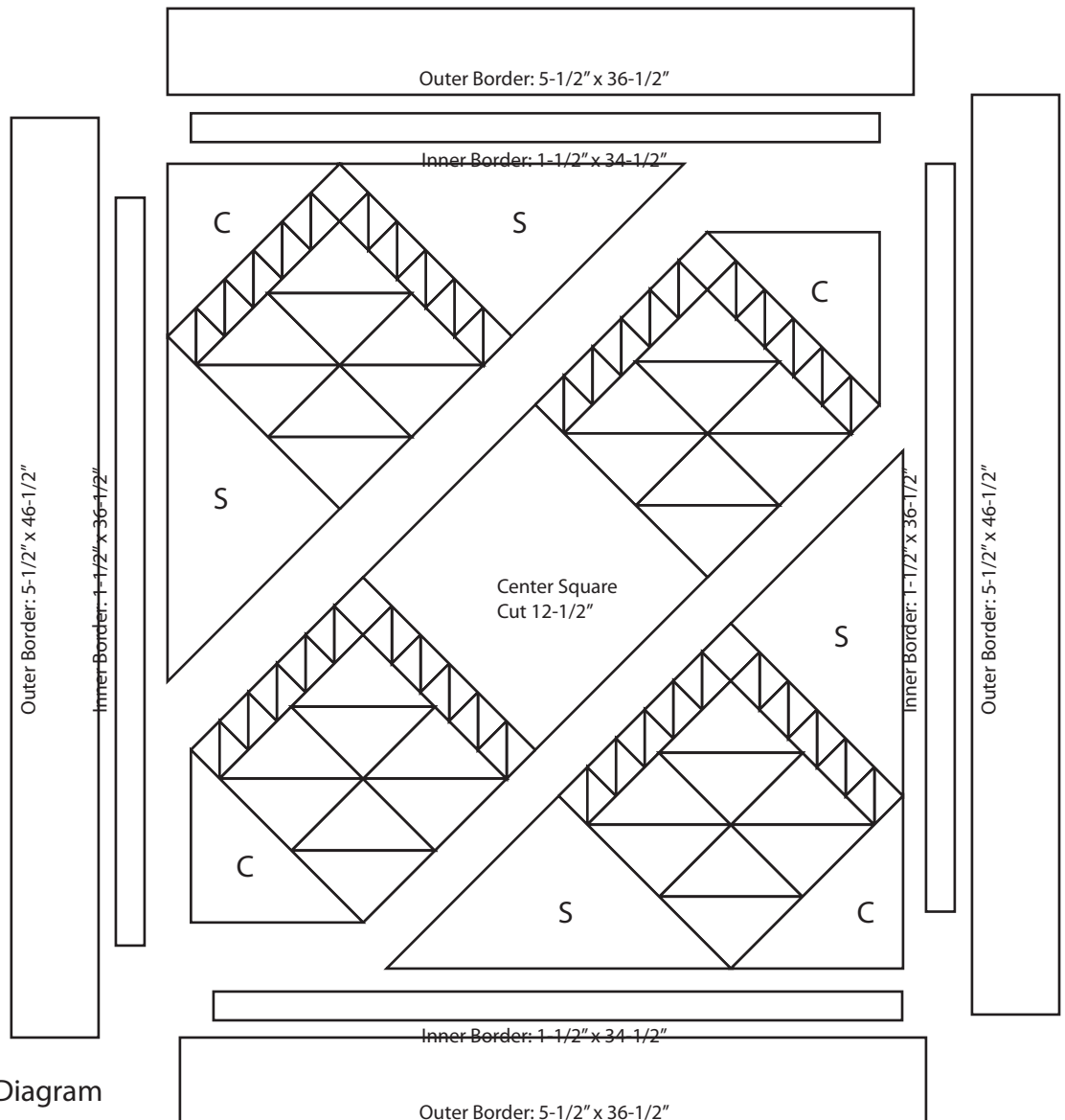
Cut 1 square 18-1/4"  
 for side setting triangles  
 S = Side Triangle



Cut 2 squares 9-3/8"  
 for corner triangles  
 C = Corner Triangle

From the remaining fabrics, piece the FOUR blocks.  
 Press seams well. Join blocks with pink center square,  
 the side and corner triangles. See Assembly Diagram  
 below. Press seams toward the triangles.  
 Add borders.

Cut 5 binding strips from the floral: 2-1/4" x wof. Seam  
 together for binding.



Assembly Diagram
