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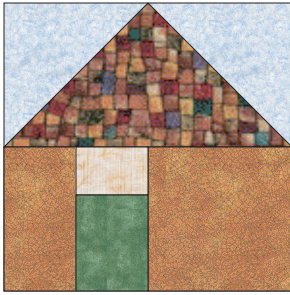

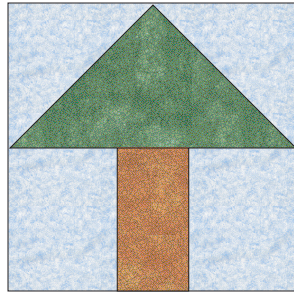

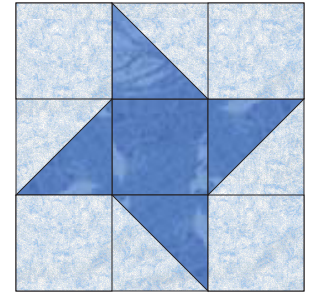
Little House - February 9

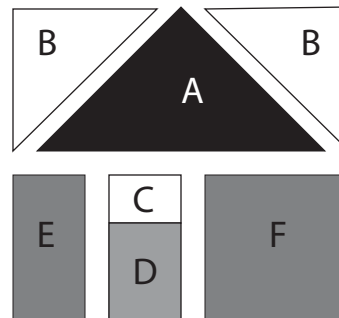

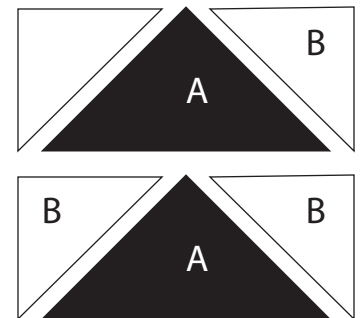
Little Star - February 11

Fabric Requirements:

Color #1 - Fat 8th gold/brown (tree trunks & houses)
Color #2 - Fat quarter cream
Color #3 - 1/3 yard light blue (sky, background)
Color #4 - 1/3 yard medium blue (star, inner border)
Color #5 - 1/3 yard green
Color #6 - 1-1/8 yard brown print (blocks, border, binding)
1 yard backing
Craft sized or 38" x 42" piece of thin batting

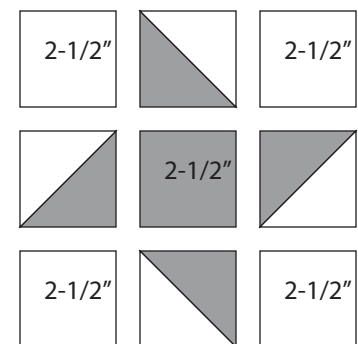

1. Making the House blocks: the roof is cut from the square indicated in your calendar. Cut the square into four triangles for the roof - Patch E (one square will yield all four roof triangles). The sky patches (F) are cut from the square indicated. Each house requires two F triangles.

2. Refer to the color pictures for the cutting of the remaining patches for the house. Sew the roof section together first; then the bottom section; finally, join the two. Make 4 house blocks.

3. Making the Lone Pine Tree variation blocks: the tree top triangles use the same size triangles as the house blocks; refer to your calendar for patch sizes. Patches C & D are NOT the same size as the C & D patches in the House blocks. Piece the tree top sections and then the tree trunk sections; finally join all into a 6" x 9" block. Make 4 tree blocks.

4. Making the Little Star blocks: Cut (16) 2-1/2" squares of light blue and (4) 2-1/2" squares of medium blue. Cut (8) 2-7/8" squares of BOTH light blue and medium blue. Cut each of the 2-7/8" squares in half to yield 16 light and 16 medium blue triangles. Pair a light and medium blue triangle as shown in Diagram 3. Sew the Friendship Star blocks together as shown. Make 4. Cut a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip of light blue for each of the blocks. Add it to one side of Star.

5. Cut (8) cream and (8) brown print 3-1/2" squares and stitch into the 4 Patch border for the bottom of the quilt.

6. Cut a green 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" strip. Join blocks, 4 Patch border and green strip into the quilt center (24-1/2" x 28-1/2")

Sashings: Measure quilt sides for the blue borders. Cut these 1-1/2" wide by the quilt center's measurement, working two at a time.

Outer borders: Measure and cut outer borders to a 4-1/4" width. Sew to two sides at a time. Press seams well.

Binding: Cut enough 2-1/4" brown print strips to equal about 150-160" in length.

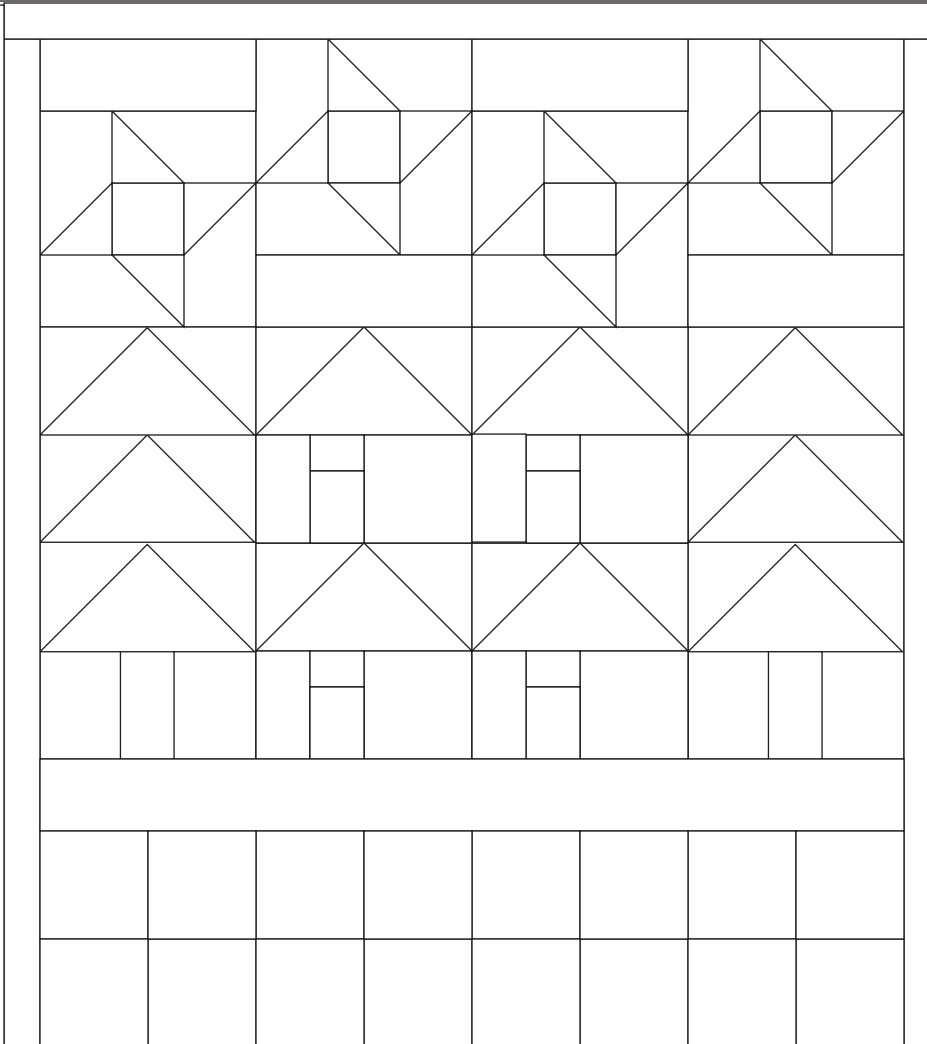
