### Fabrics - all fabrics are from the Sweetpea Collection by Jackie Shapiro for Windham Fabrics

Fat quarter of 28171-4 for elephant

Fat quarter of 28168-1 (green) background for elephant

5/8 yard of 28164-X (stripe)

1/4 yard of 28172-3 (yellow) for monkeys

1/4 yard of 28172-1 (green) for giraffes

1/3 yard of 28172-4 (orange) for first border

1/3 yard of 28169-3 (yellow) for second border

1 yard of 28170-4 (print) for border and binding

1-3/4 yards 28166-3 (yellow) for backing

34" x 56" piece of batting

1 yard paper backed fusible webbing for machine applique

Orange thread to match the applique animals

### Cutting & Appliqué

- 1. Transfer template markings of elephant, monkey and giraffe to template material (or paper side of freezer paper) and cut out. Elephant template must be enlarged by 200% for the full size needed.
- 2. Cut out a piece of fusible webbing large enough to cover each piece of fabric needed for each animal. Following manufacturer's instructions, transfer webbing to wrong side of each piece of fabric needed for each animal. Allow to cool; cut out one elephant, three monkeys and three giraffes. Remove the paper backing from each.
- 3. From the green and white print (#28168-1) for the elephant background, cut a piece 17-1/2" x 20-1/2". Center the elephant appliqué on this fabric piece and fuse in place. Using a machine zig zag or other simple, decorative stitch, appliqué the elephant to the green background.
- 4. From the striped fabric (28164-X) cut out a piece 9-1/2" x 23-1/2"

- for the background of the giraffes. Arrange the three giraffe appliqués on this piece, spacing them as shown on the color photo. Machine appliqué in place.
- 5. From the striped fabric (28164-X) cut out a piece 10-1/2" x 23-1/2" for the background of the monkeys. Arrange the three monkey appliqués on this piece, spacing them as shown on the color photo. Machine appliqué in place.

#### **Quilt Assembly**

- 6. From the orange (28172-4) cut two strips 2" x 23-1/2" and sew to top and bottom of the green elephant piece. Cut two strips 2" x 23-1/2" and sew to sides.
- 7. From the yellow (28169-3) cut two strips 2" x 20-1/2" and sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Cut two strips 2" x 26-1/2" and sew to sides. Press seams well.
- 8. Sew the monkey border to the top of this center unit and the giraffe border to the bottom. Press seams well.
- 9. From the outer border fabric (28170-4) cut two strips 4" x 23-1/2" and sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Cut two strips 4" x 52-1/2" and sew to sides of quilt center.

#### Finishing the quilt

- 10. Layer quilt top, batting and backing; quilt as desired. Trim all layers even with each other.
- 11. Cut 5 strips 2-1/4" x 42" of the border print (28170-4) and join into long strip for binding. Fold in half, wrong sides together, and sew to quilt.
